Importance of Blood

Blood expresses a person's health standing of all their organs and glands. The blood is the body's river of life. The blood transfers nutrients, oxygen and other life-giving agents to all cells in the body. The blood also removes waste from the cells to the liver or kidneys for elimination. Due to poor diet choices, chemicals and emotional stressors, the blood can resemble a swamp. These toxins are what harmful bacteria and microorganisms feed off of and the longer they survive in the body the more at risk one is for diseases. Live Blood Cell Testing can detect imbalances that other traditional lab blood tests cannot.

What is Live Blood Cell Testing?

Live Blood Analysis (Live Blood Cell Testing (LBA)) is the analysis of living blood under a powerful microscope connected to a camera.

LBA allows us to see the blood exactly as it behaves in the body in real time, providing a clear understanding of your health at a cellular level. The red blood cells directly impact the quality of your present and future health. Stress and disease appear in the blood years before they manifest in the body and have symptoms. LBA allows you to have a more thorough understanding of your own health and therefore, buy the correct supplements to avoid any unneeded therapies.

LBA is suitable for all ages, yes even children. The advantage of this test versus standard blood tests is that it may detect a problem in infant stages. Conventional blood tests kill the blood when it is prepared, thus, missing what is happening while the blood is alive and therefore not detecting diseases or early stages of future problems. LBA will show the progress of treatments for any disease.

LBA can only be performed by a technician highly trained and certified in the field.

How Does it Work?

First a drop of blood must be obtained from the fingertip using a sterile lancet. This blood droplet is then placed on a microscope slide (and covered to keep the blood alive) and immediately observed. The blood starts to die as soon as it leaves the body. The quickness of this morphology indicate your current health condition.
